

The Herbert and Irene Emde Scholarship Application

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a T.F. Riggs High School senior who will be pursuing a degree in education from an accredited college or university. The intent of this scholarship is to support a student’s efforts to become a teacher in elementary, middle school, high school or university setting. The applicant must possess academic capabilities that can handle a challenging post-secondary education. The student should model characteristics such as honesty, trustworthiness, caring for mankind, wanting to make a difference and a passion for teaching. Applicants should have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher to apply.

Selection Criteria/Requirements:

- 1) Pursing a degree in education;
- 2) Minimum 3.0 grade point average;
- 3) Enrollment in an accredited college or university.
